accommodation

Guests are accommodated in 8 original and 4 deluxe safari style tents, each with verandah, private en-suite bathroom and luxury linen provided. Tents are solar-powered to provide lighting; however, guests also have access to mains power in the Gunyah for charging batteries etc. Meetings generally take place in The Gunyah, our central lounge area and restaurant, though the entire camp is at your disposal for any other activities that may be planned.

The camp can take up to 24 people sharing, or 12 people in single accommodation. It is also possible to organise alternative accommodation close by for larger groups, with those staying elsewhere coming to Paperbark Camp for meetings, as well as all meals if required. In this instance we can cater for up to 50 people.
